May 29: Embrace the mountain spirit in Kazbegi—visit the iconic Gergeti Trinity Church and enjoy a refreshing hike to the tranquil Juta Valley. O/N Kazbegi

May 30: Journey back to Tbilisi via Mtskheta, exploring the majestic Svetitskhoveli Cathedral. O/N Tbilisi

May 31: Wrap up your adventure and depart, taking home memories of an exhilarating blend of culture, history, and natural beauty.



DETAILED ITINERARY

May 25: Touchdown in Tbilisi – Let's Party! O/N Tbilisi

Arrive in Tbilisi and check into your hotel. Unpack, relax, and get acquainted with the city's vibe. Spend the evening exploring Rustaveli Avenue, grab dinner at a cool local spot, and dive into Tbilisi's buzzing nightlife.



May 26: Discovering Tbilisi's Charms. O/N Tbilisi

After breakfast, let's set out for the Chronicles of Georgia—a monumental sculpture offering panoramic views and a dose of local history. Visit the iconic Abanotubani Sulfur Baths to experience Tbilisi's age-old spa culture. Then take a scenic cable car to Narikala Fortress and enjoy breathtaking views over the city. Later we will visit Metekhi Church, nestled by the river and offering a blend of history and architecture. Spend the evening at leisure. Whether it's checking out a rooftop lounge with a cocktail in hand or sampling street food at a lively market, Tbilisi's energy will keep you entertained.

May 27: Wine & Views in Kakheti. O/N Tbilisi

Today we will take you to the Kakheti region, Georgia's renowned wine country. Here we will visit a local winery for an immersive tasting experience, where you can learn about traditional Georgian winemaking and enjoy the flavors of native grapes.

In the afternoon, explore Signaghi, affectionately known as the "City of Love." Meander through its cobbled streets, admire the pastel-colored houses, and take in stunning views of the Alazani Valley.

Later we return to Tbilisi. Use the evening to unwind—perhaps a relaxed dinner in the Old Town or a quiet stroll along the Mtkvari River.



May 28: Scenic Journey to the Caucasus. O/N Kazbegi

Check out from your Tbilisi hotel and set off for Kazbegi (Stepantsminda). We will make our first stop at Zhinvali Reservoir for some photo ops and a breath of fresh mountain air. We will also visit the impressive Ananuri Fortress, a historical castle complex that sits along the Aragvi River, with striking views of the surrounding landscape.

On the way, we will take a quick stop at the Arch of Friendship, symbolizing the ties between Georgia and Russia. We will arrive in Kazbegi by evening, Let's go for a walk and soak in the mountain vibes.



May 29: Breathtaking Hikes & Hidden Gems. O/N Kazbegi

After breakfast, we will head out to the legendary Gergeti Trinity Church. This historic site offers unbeatable views of Mount Kazbek and the surrounding peaks.

We then embark on a hike from the church towards the serene Juta Valley. This off-the-beaten-path trek will treat you to unspoiled nature, where we can stop for a scenic picnic and enjoy the crisp mountain air.

We will return to our hotel by evening. Let's spend a relaxed evening sharing stories and playing some games.
